Canine Vaccination Recommendations

These guidelines are meant to serve as a reference and not a replacement for consultation with a veterinarian.

CORE VACCINATIONS (Recommended for all dogs)

1. DA2PP: Distemper, Adenovirus 2, Parainfluenza, Parvovirus

Begin as early as 6 weeks of age. Repeat every 3 weeks until ≥ 16 weeks of age > 16 weeks-give 2 injections 3-4 weeks apart.

Re-vaccination is performed 1 year later, then every 3 years. Some boarding/grooming facilities require annual vaccination.

2. Rabies

Puppies must be at least 12 weeks of age for initial vaccination. Administered 1 year later, then every 3 years thereafter.

NON-CORE VACCINATIONS (Administered according to risk)

Bordetella (Kennel Cough)

Intranasal and Intramuscular formulations (Intranasal preferred)

Intranasal: Booster in 2-4 weeks if first dose is given at ≤ 16 weeks of age. One dose is adequate if > 16 weeks.

Intramuscular: Initial vaccination followed by a booster in 2-4 weeks regardless of age. Must be at 3 weeks of age or older. Re-vaccination is performed every 6-12 months for at risk dogs.

Lyme

Initial injection followed by a second in 3-4 weeks. Must be at least 9 weeks old.

Re-vaccination consists of an annual booster.

Leptospirosis

Initial injection followed by a second in 3-4 weeks. Must be at least 9 weeks old.

Re-vaccination consists of an annual booster.

Other

Coronavirus, Porphyromonas, Crotalus Atrox Toxoid (Rattlesnake vaccine), Melanoma vaccine and Canine Influenza are not routinely given at this time. Exceptions may be made by the veterinarian following consultation with client regarding individual patient risk.
